Notes

- The Mustangs picked up their seventh straight win on Tuesday with a 5-1 victory over the Sky Sox. After allowing a solo homer in the first inning, Julian Garcia settled in to toss seven innings of one-run ball on just two hits with four walks and seven strikeouts. The Mustangs offense jumped in front on a three-run homer by John McHenry in the second to take a 3-1 lead. Jack O'Dowd added a run with a solo shot the other way in the fourth and the Mustangs scored their final tally on a wild pitch in the top of the ninth. C.J. Colyer threw a perfect eighth inning and Garrett Ouellette handled a scoreless ninth to close out the game.
- The Mustangs are 16-4 in their last 20 games, which is the best record in the Pioneer League in that span. They have held their opponent to 3 runs or fewer in six of the last seven games during their seven-game winning streak.
- Jack O'Dowd's third inning homerun on Tuesday was his 22nd of the year, breaking the franchise record for most in a single season in the short season era (1969 - present). John Michael Faile hit 21 long balls for the Mustangs in 2023. The full season franchise record is held by Felix DeLeon who hit 37 homers in 1962 while playing in 117 of the team's 129 games.
- Cameron Bowen has turned it on at the plate after a tough start to August. The shortstop is hitting .308 over the last 20 games, with 6 multi-hit games and a knock in 17 of the 20 contests. This comes after hitting .092 with just 3 total hits in the previous 10 games from 7/31-8/9.
- The Mustangs are still alive in the playoff chase, sitting 3.5 games behind the Missoula PaddleHeads in the second half standings. The Mustangs currently lead the tiebreaker as it comes down to runs allowed per game in the second half. Billings has allowed 5.60 R/G (241 runs in 43 games) while Missoula has allowed 6.33 R/G (266 runs in 42 games)

CRAIG MADDOX MANAGER (2nd Season)

Managerial Experience

Maddox returns to Billings for his second season as manager of the Mustangs and third season with the team, after previously being the Mustangs bench coach in 2023. Maddox, 40, played college ball at Southeastern University and was signed by the Detroit Tigers out of college. Maddox spent some time in the Braves organization in 2009 before spending the next 11 seasons playing Independent League baseball. He spent time in the Canadian-American Association, which has since merged with the Frontier League, the Northern League, the American Association and the Atlantic League. He also played two seasons in the Australian Baseball League, playing one season with the Adelaide Bite and one with the Melbourne Aces. He finished his minor league playing career in 2019 after splitting time with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (Atlantic League) and the Rockland Boulders (Canadian-American Association).

In 2021, Maddox was in the coaching world and was named the Hitting Coach for the San Francisco Giants rookie league affiliate, the AZL Giants Orange, he stayed there through the 2022 season before joining the Mustangs as the Bench Coach in 2023.



DENNIS RASMUSSEN PITCHING COACH (3rd Season)


Rasmussen, 66, returns to the Mustangs for his third season as Mustangs Pitching Coach. He was a first-round draft choice of the California Angels who went on to pitch twelve years in the major leagues. During that time, he compiled a 91-77 won-loss record with a 4.15 ERA. His best season came in 1986, when he led the New York Yankees staff with a record of 18-6 and was second in the American League in hits per nine innings with a rate of 7.12 (trailing only Cy Young Award winner Roger Clemens). Rasmussen went on to pitch for the Reds, Padres, Cubs, and Royals before retiring after the 1995 season. He later served as a pitching coach in both the Tampa Bay Rays and Boston Red Sox organizations, beginning his coaching career in Montana with the Pioneer League's Butte Copper Kings.




JOEL HARTMAN HITTING COACH (2nd Season)

Hartman, 40, returns for his second season as Mustangs Hitting Coach. A Bradenton, FL native, he played 3 years collegiately at Southeastern University from 2002- 2005, winning a national championship, before finishing his college career at Palm Beach Atlantic University. He signed his first professional contract with the Golden Baseball League in 2007 and went on to play in multiple independent leagues, including the Continental League, Frontier League, and Pecos League. After retiring as a player, Hartman began mentoring elite high school and college baseball players through Prospect Dugout. Three years later, he initiated professional baseball tryouts with Prospect Dugout and has helped more than 100 players sign professional baseball contracts.

Morrill joins the Mustangs after pitching previously this summer with the Tri-City ValleyCats (Frontier League). With the ValleyCats, he went 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 8 strikeouts against 9 walks in 10 innings across 8 games. He started the 2025 campaign with the Peninsula Pilots (Coastal Plain League) and went 1-2 with a 2.91 ERA and 12 strikeouts against 4 walks in 12.1 innings across 11 relief outings. Morrill played his final collegiate season this spring with the North Alabama Lions (NCAA D-I) after spending his first three college seasons with the Felician University Golden Falcons (NCAA D-II). With North Alabama in 2025, he went 3-2 with 3 saves and a 5.37 ERA along with 49 strikeouts against 24 walks in 55.1 innings across 17 games (2 starts).

Johnson returns to Billings after joining the team last August and posting a 2-0 record with a 5.74 ERA in 15.2 innings across 8 relief appearances last season. Before the Mustangs, Johnson played two seasons with the Marysville Drakes (Pecos League) in 2023 and 2024. With Marysville in 2024, he went 7-2 with a 2.54 ERA, 84 strikeouts and 27 walks in 67.1 innings across 12 games (10 starts). He tied for the league lead in wins and led his team in innings, strikeouts and ERA among qualified starters. He also had opportunities at the plate, often being used as a pinch hitter as he hit .177 with 3 HR and 22 RBI in his two seasons. In 2022, he played for Yuba Community College as a shortstop and pitcher. On the mound, he went 1-1 with a 5.71 ERA in 17.1 innings over 4 games. In 2020, he was a two-way player at Butte Community College hitting .389 with 3 HRs and a 2.51 ERA.

Foster makes his professional debut with the Mustangs this season. He finished his collegiate career this spring after spending four seasons with the Palm Beach Atlantic University Sailfish (NCAA D-II). In four collegiate seasons, he went 6-12 with a 5.29 ERA, 1 save, 108 strikeouts against 56 walks in 141.1 innings across 56 games (16 starts). He was used exclusively out of the bullpen during his first two years and posted a 3.10 ERA in 20.1 innings across 15 appearances during his sophomore season in 2023. Foster impressed in his first collegiate start, as he held Nova Southeastern to just one unearned run on 4 hits across 7 innings while striking out 4 and walking 1 but was stuck with a hard luck loss in a 1-0 defeat.
